

Years ago, I worked as a housekeeper (1988 to 1991). The people I worked for had tile and hard wood floors that I walked on every day and I ended up getting heel spurs. These are extra bony growths that are painful. With better arch support in my shoes it gave some relief. Over the years, the pain had lessened and it only bothered me when I would walk on uneven ground (outside in the grass) or if I walked barefoot in the house too much.

On Monday of this week (May 5, 2008), I went outside and cut my grass, which was about 8 inches high. I was outside for about 4 and a 1/2 hours. And while I did pray, it was for strength to get the job done so my arms would not hurt. I wasn't thinking about my feet at that point.

I am happy to say that I did not have any aches or pain in my arms, shoulders, legs or feet. God is so good!

Another thing I have been healed of, was pain in my lower back (in the lumbar area) The night Jim Paul was calling out back pain, then the next night I went up for prayer and Jim Paul screamed at my abdominal area. At first, I could not think of what that might be. Then later, God reminded me that I used to go to the Chiropractor for my lower back, which was out of alignment, and when that happened my pelvic girdle was out of alignment also. What would happen is that one hip would be higher than the other and the leg would be shorter than the other. So that was what the abdominal/pelvic area healing was for.

This goes back to 1998 when I fell one day at my place of employment. The steps were wet and slippery and I fell going out to my car to leave as my shift was over. When I fell, I hurt my left wrist, my back hit the step, and my neck was hurt. I went to my doctor right away and had X-rays done. The X-ray of my neck showed that the natural curve in my neck was gone, it was diagnosed as sprained. My left wrist showed two fractured carpal bones. And after that I had trouble with holding on to things. My arm would go numb and whatever was in my hand at that time would fall to the floor. After a few years, it got better.

In the last few months, I have been having some numbness in my left arm when I hold it up for an extended period of time (talking on the phone for a long time). I had gotten the person I was talking to pray with me for the numbness to go away. And it left. Then about the second or third week of April of this year I was working for my friend Nancy and not only did my arm go numb but so did the last two fingers on my left hand. There was a tingling sensation in the arm but I could not feel any thing in the fingers. This was on a Tuesday night. I called Nancy to pray with me, I thought I was having a heart attack at first, but the pain stayed in the arm and hand.

We prayed, and that night the feeling came back in the arm in about half an hour. The fingers took about two hours to have complete feeling come back in them. The next night when I went to Eagle Rock, I got Joanne Buczkowski to pray with me because the arm was slightly numb at that time.

While Jim Paul was ministering, that pain returned in the palm of my left hand but didn't travel any further.
