

Lungs healed of pneumonia

On Thursday afternoon (May 8, 2008) I was diagnosed by my family practitioner with pneumonia in both lungs. He prescribed a very strong medication to pull me back to health. He said that I would start seeing some improvement by the following Monday. Mary (my wife) saw how badly I was sick. I was out of breath just walking from the bedroom to the kitchen. Both lungs rattled with fluid, and I was spitting up a lot of colorful sputum. My chest hurt so much from the repetitive deep coughing. I was in no shape to go to church Thursday, so Mary had some prayers said for me and stood in proxy for me. She came home around 11 p.m. I believe. At that time, I was at my worst. She then prayed over me and nothing happened that instant, but I do remember thinking that I was trusting in Jesus to do a work in me and I'd find out later.

Sure enough, by 6 a.m. the next morning my coughing stopped, what little sputum that there was had turned to white, which told me that the nasty colorful infection was over, my energy level returned and I was able to breathe very well without the gurgle. Ninety-five to 98 percent of the infirmity was gone and my chest didn't hurt either. So God completely took care in seven hours what the doctor said would take four days to just start feeling better.

The second healing happened today (May 14, 2008) when I had Mary and three others pray over a sharp pain I was having around my kidney area (on the right side) that started Sunday. Again, nothing happened instantly, but over the next couple of hours it disappeared as I went about my day thanking Jesus for the ongoing healing.
